



## 19-Under Elite

The United States Amateur Baseball Federation (USABF) is accepting applications to play on its 19-Under Team San Diego for the 2010 summer season. The team will be coached by Rudy Rodriguez, and Jason Clemens of Cal State San Marcos.

Grossmont Community College will be the home field for Team San Diego 2010 and will be the site of the majority of its games. This year's team will consist of players from various colleges as well as graduating High School seniors. Playing on Team San Diego in the past has led to offers from college programs in California, Arizona, New Mexico, Colorado, Nevada, New Jersey, New York, Oregon and Hawaii.

This summer Team San Diego is scheduled to play a minimum of 25 games, Team San Diego will start its season in Palm Springs Playing the Palm Springs Power, before returning to San Diego for individual summer play. This year's Team will make it first visit to Alaska, playing in two different invitational events. Team San Diego is guaranteed a minimum of 10 games during these events. Team San Diego is scheduled to depart San Diego July 4 and return July 12. Upon return to San Diego Team San Diego will participate in the USABF Open World Series.

The fee for the Team San Diego summer program is \$2,150, which includes all tournament and game fees, travel and lodging in Anchorage Alaska, with two meals per day. Each player will be provided with many uniform items including hats, batting helmets, t-shirts, and much more.

Team San Diego is a well organized and coached team. It may not be for everyone, but if you are looking for an opportunity to play a full summer of highly competitive baseball, you may want to consider this year's team.
